Key Points:

- 1. Children's classes were clarified for the new year
- 2. The register was taken
- 3. Mrs Mellor explained that Alphonse, Ryan and Joseph are altar servers at Holy Trinity church and that this meeting is all about being an altar server at school
- 4. Mrs Wrigley explained that the altar service training begins in November. This training is for existing servers but also anyone interested in becoming and altar server and children from Year 3 can take part.
- 5. Alphonse talked about his experience as an altar server. During the summer holidays, he went to church every day and served. He sat at the altar and helped Fr Marco. He felt closer to God. Jessica said that it is good to serve as you get to see everything that the priest does. Mrs Wrigley has served for 20 year as

an altar server and she is the longest serving woman as it was only 30 years ago that women have been able to serve on the altar.

- 6. Mrs Mellor explained that we are starting a Chaplaincy Team who as part of their role will be altar servers for our school masses. The masses will be weekly. The children were asked if they would like to be part of the Chaplaincy Team. Jessica, Kamara, Lillie, Kylie, Elsa Marie, Elna, Ellie May, Joshua, Ryan and Alphonse all requested to join the team. Mrs Mellor explained that after the mass on Tuesday they would be presented with an enrolment certificate from Fr Paul. They were asked to be especially attentive during the mass in understanding where they could support Fr Paul. Mr Wrigley asked the children to listen out for the 4 bells.
