To help us grow more like you.

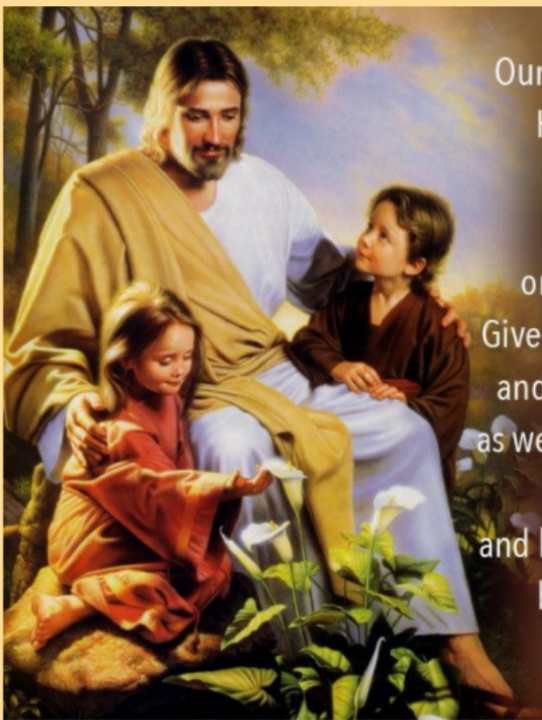
Different faces different races,

**and to the Son,**

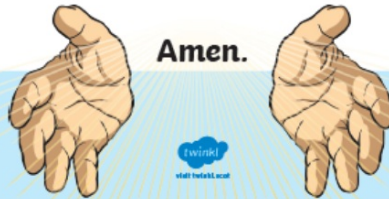
**and to the Holy Spirit.**
