

Proposed PE Premium Funding 2025/2026



Action	Cost	Impact
Staff CPD	£6000	Raising standards by developing staff expertise and improving the quality of provision for pupils. This will lead to higher-quality teaching and learning through the use of Adv4nce during the school day to observe lessons, team-teach alongside staff and deliver whole-staff training.
Increasing active participation	£3000	Additional physical activity clubs will be delivered within the school day to increase participation among targeted inactive groups including girls disadvantaged pupils and pupils with SEND.
Newcastle Sports affiliation fee	£250	This will provide pupils with opportunities to participate in organised competitive sport against other local schools promoting teamwork resilience and sporting skills.
Intra school events (equipment/prizes)	£1000	Pupils will be provided with increased opportunities to participate in physical activity and compete together as a team or house. Additional equipment or prizes will be purchased to support and enhance these events.
Improve playground facilities/equipment	£2000	This will provide pupils with increased opportunities to engage in physical activity during lunchtime.
New sporting equipment	£3000	High-quality equipment will support pupils' participation in engaging and effective PE lessons, promoting skill development and enjoyment.
Lunchtime clubs	£1000	Sports leaders will be trained to deliver traditional games, increasing opportunities for pupils to be active during lunchtime. Targeted support will be provided for inactive children to raise overall participation in physical activity.
Subsidise PE tops/ hoodies	£1000	The school will subsidise 50% of the cost of new PE tops, making them more affordable for parents, particularly for disadvantaged pupils. This will encourage pupils to take pride in their appearance and foster a sense of belonging.

After school clubs	£3000	Provide pupils with access to extra-curricular sport, including targeted clubs for disadvantaged pupils. Additional provision, such as the 'Superstars' programme, will support pupils excelling in PE in line with <i>Gold Mark</i> expectations.
